Meet Conditions & Information

1. The meet will be run under ASA Laws & ASA Technical Rules and is licensed by ASANER: L3.
2. The pool is 25m long, of variable depth, with 6 lanes and anti-wave lane ropes
3. Colorado Electronic Timing will be in operation with scoreboard display. Times displayed are for information only. Results service via Sportsystems. Results will be available for purchase.
4. Competing age groups will be Girls & Boys 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13+. Age as on 6 July 2014.
5. Entry is "**first come, first served**". No entries accepted before Friday, 30 May 2014. Closing date for entries will be **when the meet is full**.
6. Entries must be submitted on the official entry form or disk and include the swimmer's full date of birth and ASA registration number. No entries will be accepted direct from parents, they **MUST** be submitted by an authorised club representative. Entries should be returned, together the appropriate entry fee to:

7. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate fees. Entries cost £5.00 [paper entries], £4.50 [disk-based] per swim. **The 50p levy on paper entries will be donated to the Cystic Fibrosis Trust.** Cheques to be made payable to: **Peterlee ASC**
8. Confirmation of accepted entries will be sent to competing clubs prior to the meet.
9. Entries faster than the attached qualifying times will be excluded during processing.
10. Heats will be seeded by submitted entry times; swimmers not submitting an entry time will be seeded in the earliest heat(s). The organisers reserve the right to limit entries if required to ensure completion of the meet within the scheduled timescale.
11. Poolside entries MAY be accepted on the day at a cost of £5.00 subject to space being available and at the discretion of the Meet Manager.
12. Seeded heat start lists will be produced 45 minutes prior to the start time of the session. Any swimmer who arrives late and has been withdrawn by their coach will only be allowed to swim if there is an empty lane in the event.
13. Coaches/Team managers are responsible for ensuring competitors report to the marshalling area at the required time. Swimmers failing to report to the competitive marshals in time for the start of their race may not be allowed to compete.
14. All events will be Heat Declared Winner. Event results will be separated into individual age groups. Awards will be made for 1st – 3rd in each age group as per Para 4.
15. Poolside passes will cost £8.00 and include programme, lunch and results. No coach/team manager will be allowed onto the poolside without a poolside pass
16. Spectator admission will be £5.00 per day, this will include a programme. OAP's £2.50 and children free.
17. Free parking is available close to the pool.
18. Use of any photographic equipment during this meet will only be allowed subject to ASA Child Protection guidelines and any additional restrictions imposed by the sports centre.
19. Any points not covered in this information will be at the discretion of the meet organisers.
